

Accurate analysis of which antibiotic to use

The antibiotic panels for both gram negative and gram positive bacteria are carefully compiled by experts to facilitate a targeted aproach.

- 1 AMP = Ampicillin
- 2 CTX = Cefotaxime
- 3 SXT = Trimethoprim -Sulfamethoxazole (all sulfacombinations representative)
- 4 Blanco
- 5 K = Kanamycin
- 6 N = Neomycin
- 7 ENR = Enrofloxacin

- P = Penicillin
- 2 FOX = Cefoxitin
- **SXT** = Trimethoprim Sulfamethoxazole (all sulfa-combinations representative)
- CD = Clindamycin
- (representative for Pirlimycine and Lincomycin) **Ery** = Erythromycin (representative for Tylosin)
- K = Kanamycin
- **N** = Neomycin
